About the Port Authority

Founded in 1921, the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey builds, operates, and maintains many of the most important transportation and trade infrastructure assets in the country. The agency's network of aviation, ground, rail, and seaport facilities is among the busiest in the country, supports more than 550,000 regional jobs, and generates more than \$23 billion in annual wages and \$80 billion in annual economic activity. The Port Authority also owns and manages the 16-acre World Trade Center site, where the 1,776-foot-tall One World Trade Center is now the tallest skyscraper in the Western Hemisphere.

About the Program

The Engineering and Architecture Associates Program is two-year rotational program. Associates spend the first year rotating through several different Port Authority facilities in the construction or design discipline. Rotations are spent completing a series of work assignments on large- and small-scale projects involving different fields of engineering (construction) and architecture (design). Associates spend the second year of the program in their permanent position. The experience of working on a variety of projects in either design or construction management will help you develop your professional credentials while giving you the opportunity to see "the big picture" of transportation infrastructure. This program is a two-year commitment.

Eligibility and Requirements: Students graduating in Summer 2018, Fall/Winter 2018, and Spring 2019 with a bachelor's or master's degree in Architecture or an Engineering discipline are eligible to apply to the 2019 Engineering and Architecture Associate Program. Candidates are selected based on academic achievement, analytical and communication skills, and work experience.

Candidates must have a clear interest in public service management and possess a record of academic achievement.
